ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

COCHISE AMATEUR RADIO FM ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation for other than pecuniary profit under the laws of the State of Arizona, and for that purpose do hereby make, adopt, execute and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be the COCHISE AMATEUR RADIO FM ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be County, Arizona.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of this corporation shall be to sponsor a continuing program of scientific research in radio communications, especially in the very high and ultra high frequency range, through study, experimentation and the construction, operation and evaluation of types of radio repeaters and other related equipment in the Cochise County area of Arizona. The operation and use of the repeaters or equipment, besides being held in common for the use of the members of the corporation, shall be made available as an aid in communications to public and private agencies engaged in meeting local and national disasters or emergencies and in the defense of the United States of America. Further, said repeaters and equipment will be operated in the interest, convenience and necessity of the citizens of this country as provided in the rules and regulations pertaining to the Amateur Radio bervice as set forth by the Federal Communications Commission.

ARTICLE IV

The commencement of this corporation shall be the date on which actions required for incorporation are completed as required by law, and the termination of this corporation shall be as provided by law.

ARTICLE V

The affairs of this corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors of five (5) members of this corporation, including all the officers of the corporation and such additional directors as may be necessary to make the required number. All directors and officers of the corporation shall be elected annually at the annual meeting of the membership of the corporation. Such elections and other business of this corporation shall be conducted as provided by the By-Laws of this corporation, not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Arizona or the Articles of Incorporation. The officers of this corporation shall consist of a President, a Vice President, a Secretary and a Treasurer. The offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be held by one person, but this shall not be required.

ARTICLE VI

The annual meeting of this corporation shall be held on the first Monday in January of each year, or as soon as possible thereafter, at such place and time as shall be specified by the Board of Directors, with due notice thereof having been mailed to the members of the corporation at least seven (7) days prior to such meeting.

ARTICLE VII

Membership in this corporation shall be available to licensed Amateur Radio Operators and other persons interested in the purposes of this corporation, and the qualifications for membership, method of electing members and membership fees shall be as set forth in the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

There shall be no capital stock issued or sold by the corporation. There shall be no pecuniary profit accruing to the corporation or to its members resulting from the operations of the corporation. All monies which shall come into the treasury of this corporation from fees or dues from its members, or otherwise, shall be used solely in carrying out the purposes of the corporation. The indebtedness or liability of this corporation shall not exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).
